

Wildlife Achievement Chapter Distinguished Service Award

The Wildlife Achievement Chapter's (WAC) second highest award is granted to a member who has made unique or notable contributions that clearly distinguish their actions and achievements from those of other members, with performance that exceeds the requirements for the Meritorious Service Award.

Eligibility

All non-probationary members with 5 or more years of service to the Chapter are eligible.

Criteria

- * Outstanding performance in direction, leadership, or skill in devising or implementing new conservation or other highly visible programs at the Chapter.
- * Sustained and outstanding service to the Chapter in a support role for non-conservation activities over a long period of time (defined as 5 or more years).
- * Sustained and outstanding service to the Chapter in a support role for conservation related activities over a long period of time (defined as 5 or more years).
