**Location: From Gaithersburg, Rockville & Bethesda Via Rt. 355**

*Take Rt. 355 North toward Frederick. Just north of Gaithersburg, near Milestone shopping center, take Rt. 27 Right toward Damascus. Continue through Damascus but do not follow Rt. 27 North when it gets in town, continue straight (bear right at the Chevron Station). Once you pass the next light, you are on Rt.108 East. Take Rt. 108 2 miles and *turn left on Mullinix Mill Rd.* Take Mullinix Mil Rd. 1 1/2 miles and turn left into the IWLA driveway.*
