PROPOSED AMENDMENT AND CONSTITUTION CHANGES

Amendment to be voted on regarding Conservation Committee meetings:

Article II, Section 6

"A regular monthly meeting of the Conservation Committee will be held on the first Wednesday of each month at the club house, or at such other place or date, designated for cause, by the Board of Directors."

The following change in the Constitution is proposed to create the office of Membership Secretary.

Article V - A proposed new office of Membership Secretary to be added to the list of Officers following the office of Corresponding Secretary, but preceding the office of Treasurer.

The following by law changes are proposed to allow for the duties of the Membership Secretary.

Article I - Initiation Fees and Dues -- The title of Membership Secretary shall be substituted for Corresponding in each of the Sections 4, 5, and 6, under this article.

Article V - Duties of Officers -- Section 7 (new section) "The Membership Secretary shall receive all dues and deliver them to the Treasurer, maintain the membership records, mail out membership cards, prepare and mail bills to members for dues, prepare a list of delinquent members so that referrals can be made, and send monthly records of dues, new members, and address changes to the National Office."

Article V- Section 4 -- Delete all duties from the Corresponding Secretary that has been mentioned above to be the responsibility of the Membership Secretary.

It is proposed this take affect on January 1, 1959 with the office of Membership Secretary be filled during the regular election in 1958 for the 1959 officers.
