THE "ARSTERS" WERE SUPERB AND THE TRAP and SKEET SHOOT SUCCESSFUL. Thanks to Paul Jackson, Les Kenney, and the many helpers, the Spring Oyster Roast was a great feed. Also Smith DeForce reported the first Chapter Skeet and Trap Shoot, held on the same day, had a good turnout. John Ogilvie shot into first place for the skeet round with a score of 24 of 25 birds with a 28" modified pump. Some shooting! Skip Johnston placed first in the trap round with a score of 21 and was the overall runnerup. Harold J.R. Ale who is making a habit of winning shooting matches, did it again. J.R. is our club Skeet and Trap Champ with a combined score of 42 in this 50 bird event.

SO YOU MISSED IT? WELL HERE IS ANOTHER CHANCE. On June 3, we hold our ANNUAL BULL ROAST along with another 50 bird event. This event will feature one regular skeet round, and a second round with novelty shooting stations. Plan to attend this unique shoot, and get plenty of that IWLA beef at the same time. VARMIT SHOOTERS - WE HAVEN'T FORGOTTEN YOU. Coming up on Sunday, May 6, is the Spring Varmit Shoot with Don Griggs Chairing the activity. Since all shooting is under a roof, this shoot will go as scheduled come rain or shine beginning at 1:00 p.m. with a \$7.00 entry fee. Prizes will be given for each of four events and the overall high shooter. The Course of Fire will be: (1) 5 shots from the bench at a bullseye target at 100 yds, (2) 5 shots at a crow target from 100 yds, prone position, (3) 5 shots at a groundhog target from 100 yds, sitting position, and (4) 5 shots at a fox target from 60 yds, standing position. Any varmit or hunting rifle may be used from calibers .22 to .30 with any sight or scope of any power, total weight limit of ten pounds. A sling will be permitted and you must use the same rifle for all events. Bring your own ammo. This sounds like a fun event - be there.
