As you can see from the budget forecast, mortgage payments is our heavy expense area, and the only way to balance our budget is with the MES (Membership Expense Share). During this past year, we increased income from special activities such as

the Ranges (thanks to Les Kenney's expert management) the firewood and Xmas tree sales, and the rental area. Our membership increased about 10% too. This makes it possible to reduce the MES this year to \$78 from last year's rate of \$90, and the 1978 rate of \$95. We can continue these reductions, and eventual elimination of the MES if all of us sponsors a new membership each year and supports our club activities. No club in the Washington area has the facilities we have, nor the potential for the future. Our 5,000 newly planted Xmas trees look excellent and will be helping us meet expenses in about 6 years. Our Ranges are improving each year, and activities are increasing. Our clubhouse and grounds are well kept and used more often thanks to Al Wright. Our club future needs you and your support.
