PISTOL AND RANGE EVENTS (Rain or Shine)

- . 22 cal. Rimfire Handgun Shoot, Saturday, August 22 at 1 P.M. Shooting will be slow fire, at ranges of 25 and 50 yds. Any rimfire handgun with iron-sights is eligible. This will be a family team event; husband/wife or father/mother and son/daughter. Combined scores will determine the winners. Entry fee is \$5.00/team. Practice and handgun instruction provided before the match begins.
- . ADVANCED HANDGUN WORKSHOP to be held on Saturday, September 19, 9 A.M. to 12 noon, in the Chapter Clubhouse. Guest speakers will provide classroom instruction and discussion on competitive and combat firing techniques, reloading techniques and tips, custom gun display, etc. We will also proceed to the range where additional instruction will be provided. Shooters must bring their own guns, ammunition, hearing protectors and any other desired personal equipment. All children must be accompanied by an adult. A \$2.00 registration fee will cover coffee, donuts and targets. The public is invited.
