


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## **JUNE 1987**

FIRE ONLY RIFLE SLUGS FROM SHOTGUNS ON THE RIFLE RANGE. ALL FORMS AND SIZES OF SHOT ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED. SHOTGUNS ARE PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON THE PISTOL RANGE.

ALL SHOOTERS, MUST WEAR, VISIBLY, ON THEIR PERSON THE TRENT, VALID, MEMBERSHIP CARD STAMPED RANGE APPROVED WHEN USING THE RIFLE & PISTOL RANGES.
