

OUR CHAPTER SPONSORS MAJOR CLEANUP OF PATUXENT RIVER
As an activity of our Chapter's Save-Our-Streams Program, the Conservation Committee carried out a major cleanup of the Patuxent River on April 29th. More than 75 tons of trash were removed by 100 volunteers from the Izaak Walton League, Trout Unlimited, Boy Scouts of America, Maryland Department of Parks, Montgomery County government agencies and Howard County government agencies. Local business es and citizens also donated equipment, food and materials for the activity. Governor William Donald Schaefer attended the cleanup and recognized the accomplishments of the League and other organizations. Many thanks are extended to those who participated.

Such an approved member may bring ONE or TWO guests, NO MORE, at any one time, and such guests MUST be under constant and direct supervision of the approved Member. CHILDREN on the Ranges must not be permitted to use the Ranges as playgrounds. Violations of any of the rules of safety will be dealt with by the Range Committee and the Board of Directors, and will result in suspension of ALL Range privileges if found to be factual. It is up to all Members to make sure all safety rules are followed.
