

RANGE ORIENTATION AND CLEANUP will be Sunday, July 28, at 10:00 a.m.

THE CHAPTER GROUNDS will no longer be closed on Tuesday; all ground rules will apply.

- A NEW 10-BURNER GAS STOVE HAS BEEN RECEIVED AND INSTALLED in our Chapter House kitchen. For safety reasons the pilot lights will remain turned off. This new stove will be a boon for our top notch chefs, who have long needed it.
- A CONTRACT WILL HAVE BEEN SIGNED by now for the purchase and installation of ten sets of double doors and one single for the Chapter House. These will be metal doors, and will add to the appearance and security of our building.

- DUES CHANGE: On the recommendation of the Finance Committee, the Board of Directors has increased the annual dues from \$68.00 to \$85.00, effective January 1st, 1992, for that fiscal year. The initiation fee of \$15.00 will remain unchanged. This increase, the first in several years, has become necessary in part because of the low attendance at our fundraising affairs, the Bull Roast and the Chicken Barbeque.
- THE FALL CHICKEN BARBEQUE will be held on Sunday, SEptember 8, from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m., PROVIDING A CHAIRMAN VOLUNTEERS BY JULY 24th MEMBERSHIP MEETING, otherwise it WILL BE CANCELLED.
- MONTGOMERY COUNTY has levied a charge of \$2.00 for an individual bringing trash to the collection Center in Shady Grove in an automobile, and a charge of \$5.00 for a pickup truck load of trash, effective Januarylst, 1992. The Board of Directors recommends that the Chapter oppose this action on the logical basis that it will be counter-productive, resulting in a great increase in illegal dumping along roads and in fields and forests. Letters are being sent to the County Executive and to the County Council expressing our protest.
