Bring your own ammunition (or you can buy it on the grounds) if you'd like a coaching from Champion Phil Murray and other Beretta experts who will provide the clinic. The primary focus of Mr. Murray's talk and demonstrations will be on the shots and stations experienced shooters typically find most difficult as they try to get "straight". In addition, time and circumstances permitting, there will be a question-and-answer period, some one-on-one counselling, and a chance to try one of Beretta's 1992 main line shotguns, along with Mr. Murray's suggestions for Trap, Sporting Clays and other new shotgun games. If you miss the signup, or are a novice still, come anyway, even bring a few friends and relatives, just to watch Mr. Murray's shooting show. **NOTE:** cutoff for registration is **September 27th!**
