RANGE RULES NEED TO BE REVIEWED, understood and followed by everyone using the ranges. The rules are there for our protection and for the orderly management of the ranges. Most frequently

violated rules are failure to sign in <u>and out</u> at the Chapter House when using the lower ranges. Even if you have been shooting on the skeet and trap ranges and you decide to use the lower ranges also, you are still required to sign in **and** out. Under certain conditions, such as wet weather, it is necessary to bar driving to the lower ranges, at such times a sign is always posted. This is not to be ignored, on penalty of losing your shooting privileges. Please follow these necessary and common sense rules.

- IN ORDER TO KEEP OUR GROUNDS NEAT AND CLEAN, trash receptacles have been placed at various locations througout the grounds, particularly on the ranges, wherein trash generated thereon can be conveniently deposited. These trash cans are then emptied into the dumpster for transportation to County facilities. Please use the cans judiciously; with nearly 800 members we must all "pitch in".
- CONGRATULATIONS ARE EXTENDED to the U. S. Forest Service for their adoption of a draft management plan for the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness (BWCAW) in northern Minnesota. We hope their plan will stay in place and keep the area the pristine wilderness that it is. The BWCAW might seem a long way from Maryland, but to anyone who has been there, as the editor has, and appreciates nature as it should be, this is a region well worth preserving. It is not for everyone the "how can I exploit it" bunch, for example, but for anyone who wants to experience a genuine return to the time of the Voyageurs, this is the place, there is no other like it.
