

# Rifle and Pistol Range Report

INFORMATION: For more information about any of the rifle/pistol range activities mentioned in this article, contact Ray Shaver by e-mail at MRShaver@aol.com or telephone at (301) 926-0465.

SHOOTING HOURS: Permitted rifle/pistol range shooting hours are posted on the box which contains the range sign-in register. For June 2001, starting time is 10:00 AM daily and ending time is 8:00 PM, unless some activity has preempted the range. This is the latest ending time permitted by WAC policy, and will remain in place until late August. Please help us to be a good neighbor by firing no shots before the posted starting time and none after the posted ending time.

PLEASE SIGN IN AND OUT: Some members have been noticed entering and exiting the range road without signing in and out on the range sign-in register. Please note that the long-standing requirement to record your presence at the range did not change with the installation of the barrier gate. We still need the sign in/out information; so, please continue to use the range register.

BOWLING PIN SHOOT: Our first bowling pin fun shoot will be held on the uncovered pistol range following the cowboy action shoot, around 4:00 PM, on Saturday, July 28. In order to avoid disappointing serious bowling pin shooters and frightening off beginners, Jesse Lim wants to make it clear that this is intended to be an informal "fun" shoot. Other than safe handgun handling, no special knowledge or skills are required. Most centerfire pistols and revolvers may be used, but for the best results bring heavier bullets. It would also be helpful to have two spare magazines for your semiauto and two speed loaders or full-moon clips for your revolver. Although there will be no entry fee for this kickoff event, a nominal charge will be made at any future bowling pin shoots to help defray the costs we incur in running them.
