CORRECTION TO DEER HUNTER QUALIFICATION SCHEDULE:

Last month's report that we will be running a single (Sept. 22) firearms qualification event for hunters participating in Howard and Montgomery County managed deer hunts has proven to be wishful thinking. Although Howard County is all set for the September 22 qualification shoot, we failed to get the word to Montgomery County and Maryland DNR representatives who published

schedules showing the qualification shoot on November 10. Thus, we are committed to two deer hunter qualification shoots (Sept. 22 and Nov. 10) as shown in the original WAC 2002 calendar of events. We will also be running the annual hunter sight-in day for anyone who cares to attend on Sunday, November 3.
