## **<u>RIFLE/PISTOL</u>** (Wendy Smith and Jesse Lim) **<u>Rifle and Pistol Range Rules Update</u>**:

Effective August, 2010, the IWLA WAC Board of Directors approved the August 4, 2010 version of the Rifle and Pistol Range Rules. This version of the rules was reviewed and edited in collaboration with the Range Orientation Committee and the Rifle and Pistol Range Safety Officer (RSO) Sub-Committee.

In summary, the material changes should be noted as follows:

SAFETY Section:

Clarification that explosive targets are strictly prohibited (11), clarification that shots must be discharged in a controlled manner (13), removal of the word holster (17), addition of recommendation for commercially made eye and ear protection (20). The most significant change in this section is that holsters are ONLY ALLOWED at special events (i.e., Cowboy Shoots and Practical Defense Matches).

CONDUCT Section:

Rewording of original sections 9 - 12 are now summarized in item 19. Reworded item 18 to clearly state that no member may use our ranges for commercial training purposes. Item 19 has been reworded to summarize how many guests members may bring, including minor children. Addition of item 20, pets are not permitted on

the rifle or pistol ranges at any time.

FIREARMS Section:

Item 7 has been reworded to clarify that all caliber rimfire rifles and air pellet guns are permitted on the pistol ranges. Item 8 has been expanded to clarify what caliber ammunition may be fired on the covered and uncovered pistol ranges. Item 9 has been added to clearly state that firearms capable of three-shot burst or fully automatic fire may not be brought onto the WAC property at any time.

Please note that in accordance with the Rifle and Pistol Range Rules update (FIREARMS Section items 7 and 8), the following placard has been posted on the notice board between the pistol ranges. Rifle cartridges may ONLY be fired at the rifle range.
