ADULT AIRGUN PROGRAM

Would you like to improve your rifle or handgun shooting skills? Do you want to maintain your shooting proficiency by continued practice on a scheduled basis? Are you interested in learning to shoot a hand gun or a rifle? The chapter's ADULT AIRGUN PROGRAM can help you with any or all of the above. The Adult Airgun Program meets on Monday evenings (starting Sept. 12, 2011) in the downstairs airgun range at 6:30 PM. Targets are set up and firing begins at 7:00 PM and ends about 8:30 PM. You can fire air pistols or air rifles at 10 meter paper targets. There is no formal competition at these weekly shoots, but scores are recorded so the individuals can chart their progress during the year. Those wishing to can participate in a postal match during the year and we generally have an invitational match with the Rockville IWLA air pistol shooters.

Air pistol or air rifle shooting is not expensive and we have an excellent indoor facility where you can fire. We have some air pistols and air rifles that you can use to get started if you do not currently have your own.
