### ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to shoot.

It's the third of three ALWAYS for safe gun handling. It's also the law in transporting a gun in Maryland. Do not transport a loaded firearm. Keep your gun cased and as far away from you as possible and your ammunition separate. This is also a vital rule when doing dry-fire practice. Keep live ammunition out of the room in which you are practicing. Remember the maxim: Treat every gun as loaded until you verify it is not. And before you clean your gun, verify that it is unloaded. A tragic accident occurred not long ago when a man in an apartment was cleaning his gun; it went off, firing a bullet that went through the floor into an apartment below where a man who was sleeping was shot and ended up dying.
