# CHAPTER NEWS AND EVENTS

## 2022 National Convention Report

As most of you should know by now that this year is the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Izaak Walton League of America. Additionally, it is the first time in two years that we have met in person. It was good to see old friends again and make attempts at getting back to some sense of normalcy. Most of our membership really doesn't know what goes on within the League as a whole. Most are focused only on what they do at their individual chapters. While this is all well and good, the National convention is where policies are developed, rules are adopted, bylaws are changed, national officers, executive board and endowment board members are elected.

Another important function is the resolution process where the policies of the League are presented or modified. This year there were 5 presented ,but one was pulled as the government had initiated the study prior to our convention. Four others were put forward for a vote by the delegates. Wetland and ephemeral stream protection, protection of non-native game fish and curbing the use of technologically enhanced natural radioactive waste were all passed and are now in the League policy book. The fourth resolution for funding rural electrical cooperatives failed The complete listing of league policies can be found on the National website www.iwla.org

Another major change in the bylaws will allow the continued use of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary logo . The National bylaws have since its inception made the Walton bust the only official emblem of the League. With the adoption of the new logo it is hoped that more people will understand what the League stands for with this graphic depiction as opposed to Izaak's bust.

Numerous National Awards are presented at convention. These give recognition to those who have labored in the name of the League, chapters who have expanded their membership, published the best newsletters and other significant accomplishments. These awards are based on nominations from chapter membership.

The National Convention will be held in Cambridge, MD in 2024. This will be a perfect opportunity to attend since it's an easy drive. I urge you to give this opportunity serious thought. The Maryland Division is actively looking for people to step up and help with the organization of the convention and working the convention once it commences. Cherie Aker will be the point of contact at this point.

The fourth session of the USAA Level 1 Archery Classes of the 2022 WAC Youth and Adult Archery Program are being offered in three classes to be held on the following Saturday mornings: October 1, October 8 and October 15, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the club's Field Archery Range (located on the right just after you enter the club driveway). All equipment will be provided for students to use during class sessions. This includes a traditional or compound bow, arrows, an arm guard and finger tab. Students are welcome to bring their own personal equipment but such equipment must be inspected and approved for use by an instructor. The fee is \$25.00 per participant for all three classes. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and is only by email. Please note that a new policy change requires that WAC Chapter members be registered first and, thereafter, non-members will be registered according to availability.

To register, please contact John Porter at porter253@aol.com as soon as possible. John will email you the Registration Form and the Waiver and Release Form for you to complete and email back to him. As forms are received, you will be notified by email to confirm that you are either registered in the session or are on a waiting list. Please make your check for the registration fee payable to "Wildlife Achievement Chapter" in the amount of \$25.00 per participant and bring it with you to the first class. Please note that your registration is not fully confirmed until the required forms and check have been received, so do not delay as the class enrollment is very limited.
