IWLA WAC Air Rifle Outdoors end of year report. (Mark Mayer)

The 2025 outdoor air gun calendar finished on Saturday November 8 with our final 60 shot field target match of the season, with the shooters, equipment used, and scores below. Of the 60 shots, six are from the offhand position and six from the kneeling position; these are counted as decimal points added to the total score. A perfect score would be 60.66

Our matches are run by DIFTA (Damascus Ike's Field Target Association) and follow rules set by the American Airgun Field Target Association (AAFTA). During the 2025 season we ran 7 matches, in which a total of 69 shooters competed, with \$870 in match fees collected for the chapter. Our season runs from March – November.

In field target competitions points are scored by knocking down targets, which requires hitting a paddle (the kill zone) that lies behind a face plate that often resembles some form of critter. Hits to the face plate lock the target in an upright position and are counted as misses. Clean hits to the paddle cause the whole target to fall down, scoring a point. In the examples below the kill zones are 0.5 inch diameter. During a match targets are set out at unknown distances from 10-55 yards, with kill zones ranging from 3/8" to 2.0". Our air rifles are limited to 0.177, 0.20 or

0.22 pellet size, with a maximum power of 20 ft/lbs, and for range finding are fitted with scopes with adjustable parallax, and variable magnification.

Please submit your for sale items, in the format below with a 12pt Arial font, with black letters only. Include condition, price, brand, your contact information (on each item) and a description of the item for sale. For firearms, include the barrel length, caliber, finish, condition and model number. Do not underline or make any text bold or in color. Please limit the number of ads to 6 per member. We are not responsible for pricing errors or seller's content. Ads will only be listed in the online version of the newsletter since there is not a space limitation and will be listed as received (copy and pasted) without any edits.

Items must be your personal property and not for business purposes. We do not post commercial sales. Use upper and lower case letters, do not use all caps. Do not send spreadsheets or formatted columns. Please do not send the ad as a file, send it in the text of a regular Email. Do not use bold text except for the brand. Each ad should be written individually. Include your name, membership

number and contact information **after each ad**. Items must be firearm, archery, fishing, boating or shooting sports related.

"Want ads" will need to have contact information and adhere to formatting requirements, but the content can be as general or specific as needed depending on the item that you are looking to acquire.

Deadline is by the End of Day on the last Monday of the month. Ads will be listed in the order received.

For additional information, please contact the seller directly.

Items that are over 6 months old will be deleted unless you send a renewal of the ad. Please advise Forrest if the item has been sold or is no longer for sale. Ads will be removed, after the date (that I populate) at the end of each ad based on the date it was added to the newsletter. All transactions are between the seller and buyer and Federal and State Laws must be followed for all firearm transfers. Handgun and now long gun transfers in Maryland require that the transfer be made by a licensed dealer or through the Maryland State Police. All firearms purchased from out of state or through the Internet must also go through a Federal Firearms dealer within your state. The FFL must be at the recipients (buyers) end, not the shipping end. It is often difficult to find a dealer that is willing to take on sales that were not originated by them. We have two of our members Alex Rozental and Rick Lopez that own Damascus Outdoors (formerly AM Shooting) located here in Damascus at 9861 Main St., across from the old Druid Theater.
