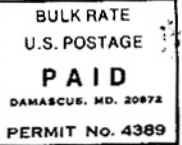

MEMBERS WHO ARE RANGE APPROVED AND WHO BRING GUESTS MUST LIST EACH GUEST BY NAME AND MAY ONLY BRING THEM TWICE. AFTER WHICH THEY MUST BECOME MEMBERS.

A NEW PROCEDURE IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR ALL THOSE WHO WISH TO BE RANGE APPROVED TO USE OUR RIFLE & PISTOL RANGES.
